

Bible Quiz Rules

1. Each team will consist of five members.*****
2. Each match will consist of two rounds.
 - a. The first round will be written.
Five questions will be asked
All five team members will have a pad and pencil to write the answer.
There will be one point awarded for each correct answer.
There will be no deduction for a wrong answer.
 - b. The second round will be a speed round
Ten questions will be asked.
Each team member will have a buzzer with which they may buzz in.
The first one to buzz in will light up the control box, blocking others from buzzing
There will be one point awarded for a correct answer.
There will be one point deducted for an incorrect answer.
The contestants may buzz in at any time
The quizzer will stop reading the question once someone has buzzed in.
3. A tie will be broken by the asking of three additional questions.
4. Any “Quotes” or anything in “Quotation Marks” must be answered “word perfect”
5. Each team member will take a placement test on Monday, immediately following supper, so that the teams may be correctly bracketed. This will be a written test.

*****A team may consist of fewer players, but it will put this team at a definite disadvantage because it hinders you from obtaining all the points possible during the written round.
